

Spiritual Development

- Continuing with our long-standing tradition, we open each chapter meeting with a 5-10 minute devotional delivered by the Chaplain or a member appointed by him.
- Built-up our Spiritual Committee.
- Following the devotional, prayer requests are taken orally. We then lift those requests up in prayer.
- Prayer requests are e-mailed out the next day in our Chapter Announcements e-mail and are posted on the chapter bulletin boards as a continued reminder.
- Created a new Membership Church List that is posted on the bulletin boards.
- Chapter Church.
- Maintained a weekly Bible study.
- Beginning in the fall semester bible studies were centered on specific questions including: dating and relationships, stress, discerning Gods will, and submission just to name a few.
- We host a prayer breakfast for the entire Greek community, providing our chapter house and breakfast.
- The fall pledge class participated in a pledge bible study that was conducted by two older brothers.
- Joint praise and workshop w/social sororities.
- The chaplain posts lists of meeting times for various on-campus Christian groups such as Campus Crusade for Christ, Intervarsity, and Fellowship of Christian Athletes.
- Bible “verse of the day” is designed and then posted throughout the house for spiritual references.
- Start a brunch and church program with girls on campus
- Implement church and a lunch every Sunday.
