

Darl & Florence Snyder New Horizons Scholarship The FarmHouse Foundation

The purpose of the Darl & Florence Snyder New Horizons Scholarship is to broaden the horizons, exposure and experience of FarmHouse undergraduates through study abroad programs and international student travel opportunities. Through the generosity of Darl (IA '42) & Florence Snyder, a \$300 scholarship will be awarded to one member of FarmHouse Fraternity participating in a university sponsored study abroad opportunity during the 2011-2012 academic year. The intent of the scholarship is to support the expenses associated with study abroad.

The recipient must be an initiated member of FarmHouse Fraternity, enrolled at a university hosting a FarmHouse Chapter and carry a schedule typical for their classification. The recipient must have a grade point average above or equal to the chapter's average and shall maintain satisfactory behavior.

Scholarship applications must be forwarded to the Foundation's International Office bearing a postmark no later than **June 1, 2012**. Selection of the recipient will be made by a committee appointed by the FarmHouse Foundation Trustees.

Applications are to be submitted in the following format, but applicants are not confined to limiting their application to the space provided on this form.
