Honorary Membership Nomination

Honorary Membership recognizes men of high character with great professional achievement, who embody the ideals and values of FarmHouse Fraternity. This type of membership into the Fraternity may only be conferred by the International Executive Board. To be eligible for Honorary Membership, a man must be outstanding in agriculture, its related fields/sciences or his profession. He must fulfill the objectives and high standards of FarmHouse and he must be a source of inspiration to his peers and colleagues in his personal and professional communities. Such a man is entitled, upon becoming a member, to enjoy the full rights and privileges granted to all members of the Fraternity. A man who is nominated for Honorary Membership in FarmHouse may not be a member of any other social fraternity.

Nominations for Honorary Membership should consist of a nomination letter from a FarmHouse chapter, alumni association, faculty advisory committee, chapter member or an alumni member of the Fraternity and a resume of the nominee. In addition to the nomination letter and resume, at least three letters of support should be included from other sources, such as industry or business leaders, professional colleagues, university leadership or civic organization contacts.

Nominations are accepted at any time, but are reviewed on an annual basis and due to the International Office by April 1, 2012. Address entries to:

Submitted materials will be reviewed by the Awards Committee, as selected by the Awards Chair, Garry Weston (KY '98) and International President, Brent Bible (PU '93). Final selection is made by the International Board of Directors, based on the recommendations of the Awards Committee.

Men invited to join FarmHouse Fraternity through Honorary Membership will be contacted by the International President. Honorary Members will be initiated at a time convenient and appropriate for the individual, but are encouraged and invited to attend the 47th Biennial Conclave, August 1-5, 2012, in Minneapolis, Minn. so that the International Fraternity may recognize and welcome the Honorary Member publically.
